

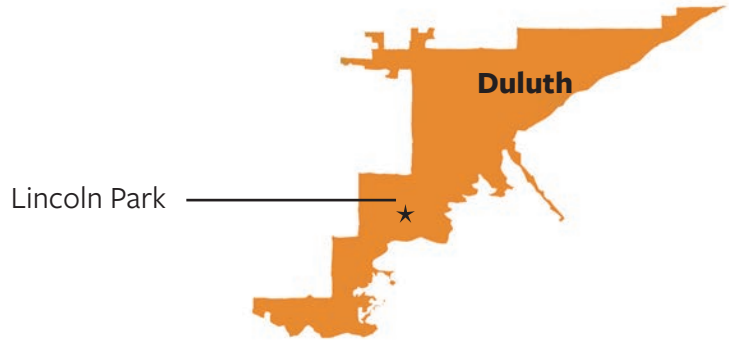

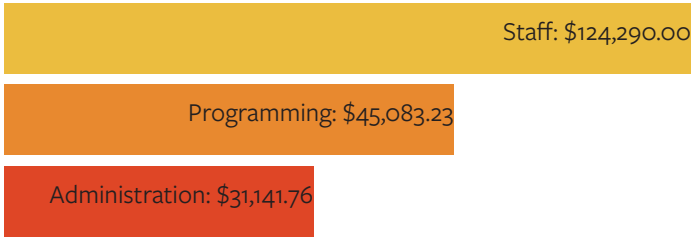
The Mission of Lincoln Park Children and Families Collaborative is to strengthen the Lincoln Park community by connecting families who care about young children.

Geographic Service Area

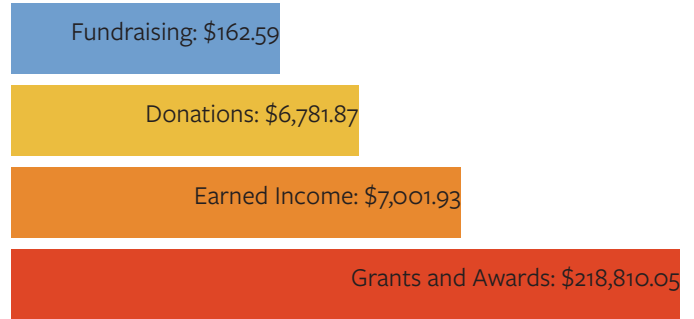
LPCFC serves people who live in the Lincoln Park neighborhood area of Duluth. Our Circle of Security classes serve the city of Duluth and the surrounding area.
